





NOTES FROM THE PASTOR

KEITH INMAN

She watched us for just over a year. She listened. She received love and genuine care. Drawn into family. And then, she professed Christ. She has now returned to her home country as a believer, part of the Body of Christ. She represents others who have done the same as a result of God gracing FBC to express the love and salvation of Christ to the world which ends up on our doorstep. Just amazing!

Parents come to our worship service. They desire to come and see the people of First Baptist Church who have been a part of answered prayers. Some arrive from a home a few hours away. Others come from other continents, drawn by love to encourage their child and to express gratitude to FBC for providing a “home away from home.” Just amazing.

How do we put a number to the team which has formed to create a ministering mosaic to students? It's not possible. It's just amazing.

We have the responsibility and privilege of representing and presenting Christ in our community. We do this by following Christ, by authentic worship, and by being transformed by the Truth of His Word. We create an atmosphere of love in our Welcome Center, our hallways, our classrooms, our church vehicles, our vans, our cars, our sanctuary, our homes. We create an atmosphere that is morphed by the presence of Christ. His Spirit warms the hearts of our Body to touch the hearts of those who need Jesus. It's amazing.

A friend is in turmoil. He has lost a loved one in a most tragic way. He is struggling to make sense of it all. He wonders if he can go on. His friends surround him. His friends offer him hope. His friends offer him Jesus. His friends call in one of our ministers for support. And in an atmosphere filled with the Spirit, a circle of love forms, and hugs usher into the Kingdom a new brother in Christ. It's amazing.

Coaches sign up. Spouses offer support. Children watch parents. Parents watch children. Grandparents have love on their face. Referees find their whistle. Students join the leadership and youngsters feel special. An atmosphere is created. People care. And people share. Conversations go “below the surface.” There's still hope even in the midst of life's disappointments and pain. Jesus is here. It's Upward Basketball. It's Upward Cheerleading. It's amazing.

People gather for worship. Hands are held. Hands are raised. Hands are held open in reverence. God's children express their love for God. Songs are sung. Tears roll down. Prayers are lifted. Intercession is offered. Scripture is studied. Gospel is proclaimed. Hope is extended. It's amazing.

I am so grateful to live this story with you and serve with a wonderful staff. I thank you for your support in every way: emotional, spiritual, physical, and financial. You bless us. It's amazing.

Note: This year's luncheons and dinners will be held in the Family Life Center unless told otherwise.




On Sundays in February we are learning about Esther, Nehemiah and the wall being rebuilt, Malachi the prophet, and from Adam to Jesus.






